
2018 Careers Practitioners' Seminar – In review

The theme for the day was 'Graduate Employability – addressing the ways in which we strive to prepare our graduates for the jobs and skills of the future'. Attendees heard from our Vice Chancellor, Professor Jane den Hollander AO who spoke about the changing nature of the global workforce and the implications for how careers develop. Professor Dineli Mather, Pro-Vice Chancellor (Graduate Employment) then presented on how Deakin is equipping our students to navigate graduate employment in the 21st century. Attendees also explored the campus in a range of interactive and engaging workshops that showcased many of the state-of-the-art facilities available to students.
