

Visitor parking is available at our Burwood, Waurn Ponds and Warrnambool campuses.

Unfortunately there is no visitor parking at our Waterfront campus, but there is plenty of <u>on-</u><u>street parking</u> nearby.

Where to find visitor parking

Visitors can purchase a permit to park in 'General permit zones' (white bays). Please don't park in orange or green bays as these require a different permit type. Find car park locations on our campuses here.

Permit options

CellOPark - permits can be purchased once you have created a CellOPark account. It's best to do this before visiting campus - you'll need your credit card and vehicle registration. Only complete mandatory fields - do <u>not</u> select an institute. Please take care to enter your vehicle registration correctly.

Once you have an account, it's easy to start/stop a parking permit session via the CellOPark app (free to download), the CellOPark website or their call to park service - ph: 9111 1799.

Parking permit machines - available at our Burwood and Waurn Ponds campuses only. These user friendly machines accept Visa and MasterCard debit and credit cards - sorry no cash or coins. Please take care to enter your vehicle registration correctly.

Burwood campus - machines can be found in car park 1, car park 5 (level 1), car park 6 (levels 1 & 4) and outside building LA on Uganda Street.

Waurn Ponds campus - machines are located on Nicol Drive North and Nicol Drive South.

Free parking options

Geelong campuses: a free and reliable park and ride bus service operates from the Barwon Valley Activity Centre in Belmont. Click here for more info.

Waurn Ponds campus: CP20 is a free car park. The campus map can be found here.

Warrnambool campus: Parking in 'General permit zones' (white bays) is free.

Accessible parking

All our campuses have accessible parking spaces for students, staff and visitors with Category 1 Disabled Persons Parking permits (issued by local councils). Category 1 permits must be clearly displayed at all times. A Deakin parking permit is not required.

Category 2 Disabled Persons Parking permit holders are **not** permitted to park in accessible parking bays. However, vehicles displaying a Category 2 permit are permitted to park in a 'General permit zone' for double the duration of their paid parking.

Parking infringements

Parking infringement notices may be issued for vehicles that don't have a valid permit or that are illegally parked. Instructions on how to pay an infringement or how to request a review can be found on the reverse side of parking infringement notices.

All requests for review are facilitated by Bartels Taylor and Associates on behalf of Deakin University.

Our car parks are often in high demand, particularly during the first few weeks of Trimesters 1 and 2.
