

Bachelor of Social Work coming to Warrnambool

We are excited to announce that the Bachelor of Social Work will be offered at our Warrnambool campus from Trimester 1, 2023, in addition to the Geelong Waterfront campus and online. If your students are passionate about human rights Deakin's Bachelor of Social Work will equip them with the knowledge and skills to enhance the wellbeing of others through an understanding of policy, socioeconomic factors and social equity issues.

With job opportunities in the sector expected to grow by 23.3% by 2026, your students will graduate career ready with the skills to work effectively with individuals, families and communities to enable social change. 1000 hours of practice education placement gives them invaluable hands-on experience.

If your school is in a regional or rural area your students can also apply for this course through our Regional and Remote Entry Scheme so they help address the key factors causing inequality in their own communities.

Exciting news for Deakin's School of Nursing and Midwifery

In June 2022 the Burwood campus opened five new simulation wards, additional student practice spaces, treatment rooms and high-fidelity simulation spaces. These new teaching and learning facilities will provide a fantastic student experience in a fully simulated new hospital environment, preparing students to manage challenging scenarios to ensure quality and safe patient care. This project included co-contributions from the Victorian Higher Education State Investment Fund (VHESIF).

Both our Geelong Waterfront and Warrnambool campuses also have high fidelity simulation spaces and 3G mannikins providing crucial hands-on practice for students of our **Bachelor of Nursing** and **nursing combined courses** across multiple campus locations.

All three campuses will be running tours of their state-ofthe-art facilities during our Campus Open Days – Geelong Waterfront Sunday 7 August, Warrnambool Sunday 14 August and Melbourne Burwood Sunday 28 August.

Therapy dogs bring calming cuddles to Deakin res in study week

As Trimester One ended, students across Deakin Residences were busy preparing for exams and completing assignments. Though it's the culmination of months of rewarding learning, Study Week (or SWOTVAC) can be a stressful time, so we called on some canine companions to provide some much-needed downtime.

Volunteer handlers from the Delta Society brought their therapy dogs to campus in Burwood and Waurn Ponds, allowing students to interact with these well-trained pooches and each other. From Jack Russells to Border Collies, Poodles to Greyhounds, the group of dogs was diverse and for the students it was an opportunity to de-stress, catch up and enjoy a moment of calm.

While it might have seemed like incidental fun for the students, research shows that sessions like this can help to improve physical well-being, decrease anxiety, ease social isolation and increase positive mood.

When asked about their experience of the sessions, students responded positively, with Waurn Ponds resident Jayden saying "It was a really nice break from study and a good excuse to hang out with friends and pat the doggos."



The volunteer handlers were impressed by our students' interactions with the therapy dogs, with handler Richard saying, "The reaction we get is amazing. The smile comes on their face and they just relax. It's a distraction from their day-to-day pressures and just being able to relate to the dogs."

This is an important part of the health and wellbeing programming covered within Deakin Residential Services' Student Experience Pillars. We look forward to welcoming these beautiful dogs back in the future.

A new national survey by Deakin University has revealed that while nearly all Australians (97%) believe that Australia is a sporting nation, there is still low awareness of the projected industry growth and career potentia in sport.

The survey comes as Australia is set to enter 'The Golden Decade of Sport' with the nation anticipated to host 10 major global sporting events over the next ten years, generating thousands of job opportunities for those interested in sport-related fields.
